Stephens has received external grants from NCA, CPRIT, U.S. Census Bureau, TxDOT and Hewlett Packard. She is the current ICA Secretary of the Organizational Communication Division, and she was the 2013 recipient of the Eyes of Texas Teaching Award.

Her research focuses on using redundancy and multiple communication technologies to examine multicommuting in organizational meetings, health communication, crisis messages, emergency communication and overload.
